



Chase the Ace rules:

- A standard deck of 52 playing cards will be used.
- Participants are sold tickets that are drawn for a winner. That winner will get the Nightly share of 20% then has a chance to cut the deck for the Ace of Spades and the Jackpot. The Jackpot will have a starting amount of: \$5,000.
- The nightly ticket sales breakdown is 50% to Titan Foundation, 20% for the Nightly winner, 30% goes into Jackpot.
- To participate, purchase tickets (generated and printed by 5050 Central) at the KC Irving Regional Center during the 2016-17 regular hockey season (see attached schedule). If the Ace of Spades is not drawn during the regular hockey season, the draw will continue during the play-off games (schedule to be determined). If the Ace of Spades is not drawn during the play-off games; the draw will continue on Wednesday's from 6:00pm to 9:00 pm. All tickets will be sold at the KC Irving Center.
- The Home Game 50/50 draw will not be held at hockey games, during the same time that the Chase the Ace draw is ongoing.
- For selling times during the regular hockey season, the sales will start 1 hour before the beginning of the game and sales will close 5 minutes into the third period (15 minutes left on the score clock in the third period). See attached Titan Home Schedule for dates and times.
- Selling times during the play-off will be the same as the regular hockey season; the sales will start 1 hour before the beginning of the game and sales will close 5 minutes into the third period (15 minutes left on the score clock in the third period). The play off season schedule is not predetermined. Therefore, there is an advertising plan attached.
- For selling times during a Wednesday extension will be from 6:00 to 9:00pm at the KC Irving Center. If the Ace is not drawn during the play-off games; the draw will continue on Wednesday's at the KC Irving Center. Therefore, there is an advertising plan attached.

- Participants must be in attendance to win. In order to be eligible and participate in the draw, the ticket holder must remain present. The draw will be done manually and the winning ticket number will be drawn from tickets printed by the 5050 Central barrel printers.
- Once the winning ticket number is drawn it will be announced loudly and clearly and displayed visually, repeatedly for at least 20 minutes until the winner comes forward. If no winner comes forward, the number will again be announced as VOID and a new ticket number will be drawn and the process repeated.
- Both before and after the draw, the deck of cards will be displayed in such a manner as to confirm that the Ace of Spades is in the deck. After each draw, the deck of cards will be secured in a sealed envelope and locked within a safe.
- When a winner comes forward with their winning ticket they receive 20% of that evening's ticket sales. 30% of that evening's ticket sales will then be added to the jackpot. They then cut the deck of cards and retrieve one card from the deck. If they do not pull the Ace of Spades, then the card pulled will be removed and destroyed as to not be played again.
- If the Ace of Spades is drawn, the winner will receive their 20% (of that evening's sales)/winnings plus the additional 30% (of that evening's sales) as well as whatever amount has accumulated in the rising jackpot, which includes the starting jackpot amount and then the game will be officially declared over.
- 50% of the evening's ticket sales will go to the Titan Foundation.
- Tickets cost: 3 for \$5.00 each, 9 for \$10.00, or 30 for \$20.00.
